STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALL WEBSF COMPETITIONS

Where players are more than 15 minutes late for the commencement of a match he/she shall forfeit the first frame, if after waiting a further 15 minutes the match will be forfeit. Under these circumstances the entry fee is non-refundable.

1. Membership and completed registration form must be received before entry into any of the WEBSF tournaments unless the tournament is declared 'Open'
2. The WEBSF dress code must be adhered to. The Tournament Director will refuse entry or disqualify any player failing to comply when challenged.
3. All WEBSF Tournaments – Smart dark trousers, dark shoes a choice of waistcoat, single colour collared shirt (bow tie optional) or a single colour collard polo shirt. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. (no jeans or trainers)
4. Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent at all times whilst in the match rooms.
5. Dates and venues may be changed at the WEBSF's discretion
6. The format of play shall be confirmed on the day of the competition by the Tournament Director
7. The Tournament Directors decision will be final with regard to all decisions relating to the tournament
8. All members and players are bound by the WEBSF Tournament Rules, and Codes of Conduct, copy of which will be available at all WEBSF tournaments and can also be found on-line (websfsnooker.com/websf-policies-procedures).
9. All prize monies shall be subject to entries received.
10. The WEBSF dress code must be adhered to during play.

Bronze Tournaments – Smart dark trousers, dark shoes, collared shirt or single coloured polo shirt with collar. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Strictly no jeans, shorts or trainers

Gold, Silver & Open Tournaments – Smart dark trousers, dark shoes, waistcoat, bow tie (optional) or single coloured polo shirt with collar. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Strictly no jeans or trainers.

Entries shall be regarded as an acceptance of these terms and conditions. In the event of any misconduct, infringement or other matter considered inappropriate by the Tournament Director or WEBSF Officials present, the decision of the WEBSF Tournament Director shall be binding. This may include refusal of entry, disqualification at the time and lead to rescinding of WEBSF membership.
