The West of England Billiards & Snooker Foundation understands the importance of new technology for children and young people’s development. However we recognise that relevant safeguards need to be put in place to ensure children and young people remain safe whilst online or using social media.

We ask that all parents/carers spend a few minutes to read through and discuss this policy with their child/children and then sign and return this form addressed to the WEBSF Champion and Head of Coaching via their local Area Coach.

- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using the internet and other online media including any resources I access and my use of language.
- (where access to ICT facilities are available within a venue) - I will not deliberately browse, download or access material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I will report this to an adult.
- I will not use social networking or the internet to send anyone material that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or illegal.
- I will not give out any of my personal information such as name, age, address or phone no.
- I will not share my passwords with anyone else.
- I will not arrange to meet someone unless accompanied by a member of staff or parent/guardian.
- I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and if they are not followed my parents/guardians may be contacted.
